You must take the exam in one of the MC assessment centers between March 6 and March 12.
You will find the exam under assignments, and open it, and then the assessment center will put in the password.

You will have 2 hours and may not use any notes, books, cell phones, or any internet pages other than Blackboard.

You may only take the exam once. You may notice it says multiple attempts. This is ONLY so that you can restart the exam if the system crashes while you are taking the exam. If that happens, restart immediately and continue where you left off. I will combine the two attempts.

The midterm exam covers material from weeks 1-5: There are 8 essay questions. The exam covers recursion, pointers, searching, sorting, pointers, loops, files, arrays, parallel arrays, and formatting output including width and number of decimal places. You may be asked to explain a concept and/or give code to illustrate.

You must answer all questions without books or notes or any other aide. The assessment center will provide scratch paper.
